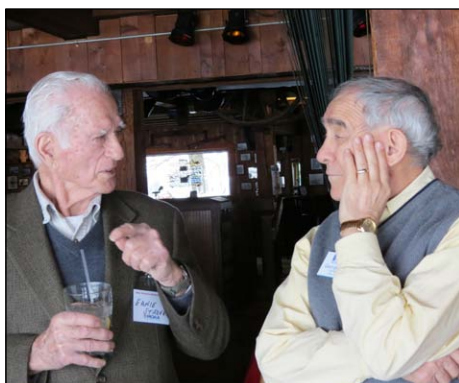
Can Playing Cards Prevent Suicide?

At our Jan. 21st meeting, Lisa Newburger, LISW-S, the owner of Discuss Directives, LLC held a focus group with MOAA to take a look at a new suicide prevention product called Heart2Hearts[®] Army Edition cards. She had been asked to create this product by the army and has even given a briefing about them at the Pentagon last February. The purpose of these cards is for earlier identification of signs of clinical depression with the goal of intervention. They are conversation starters and thought provoking ideas that are useful in identification of depressive symptoms. The cards are geared for every branch of the military including veterans and has resources whether you are deployed or in the states. Commissary in Pittsburgh (Moon) Gets Final Go-Ahead to Start Construction Fall 2013

There have been talks about the \$17 million facility for several years, which has the bipartisan support of the entire state Congressional delegation, but the final approval it needed was being held up by the Senate Armed Services Committee. The Pentagon leaped the committee in a letter issued by deputy undersecretary of defense Jo Ann Rooney, which basically said the necessary funding approval was in place to get the project started.

"Since Congress appropriated funds for construction of the commissary, I have determined that additional Congressional approval is not required for construction to proceed," the principal deputy undersecretary for personnel and readiness wrote Dec. 1.

The Defense Commissary Agency could issue requests for proposals on the construction in the next 45 days. After bid reviews, construction of the 43,000-square-foot facility at University Boulevard and Business Loop Interstate 376 could begin next fall.

The new commissary for 168,000 eligible military personnel and veterans in the area—is supposed to replace the Charles E. Kelly Support Facility in Collier. Federal officials announced in 2005 that Kelly would close as part of a national restructuring of bases.

Editor's Note: On February 3rd, the Air Force announced plans to close the 911th Airlift Wing in Pittsburgh within the next two years, moving two of its seven C-130 transport planes to other bases and retiring the rest.
